

## A. ACTIVITIES WHICH ARE NOT UNDER COMMUNITY SERVICE

Examples of activities which do not fall under Community Service include but are not limited to:

- Substance abuse treatment programs (See Section 24.8)
- Mental health (See Section 24.8) and family violence counseling
- Life skills training (See Section 24.8)
- Parenting classes (See Section 24.8)
- Job readiness classes (See Section 24.8)
- Caring for a disabled family member (See Section 13.8)
- Shoveling a neighbor's driveway
- Running errands for a neighbor
- Arranging or keeping doctor's or vision/dental appointments
- Arranging housing
- Arranging transportation or day care
- Serving as a foster parent
- Attending meetings with the child's teacher, principal, or school counselor
- Parents reading to their child(ren)
- MDT meetings
- WV WORKS orientations
- Assessment testing

**NOTE:** Under no circumstances will Community Service participation be allowed at active CWEP and JOIN contract sites, **nor at a site which has employees in layoff status.**
