

FAQ AFA 03-2016 Children's Crisis Response Services Program Updated 5/20/15

Q: On page 3 of the AFA in the paragraph under Funding Availability it says one residential unit will be funded. On page 11 under Service Overview it says the Crisis Response System will consist of Two Crisis Response Programs. Is this AFA speaking to funding one or two programs?

A: AFA funding is available for one children's crisis response services site. We have one existing program in the southern part of the state. When this grant is awarded there will be a total of two program sites in the IDD crisis response services system for children.

Q: Regarding the data requested in the proposal narrative, the target population is very specific. Where is the best source of data that is limited by age and diagnosis?

A: It is the responsibility of the applicant to conduct research required for submission of a successful proposal.

Q: In section B, the AFA asks for identified screening tools but explains that these tools are NOT admission criteria or assessments. What type of tool is desired?

A: The current AFA has a link within the proposal which contains a variety of screening tools.

Q: Do we need to have prior approval from the state to add capital items to our budget?

A: It is recommended that applicants submit one budget for operations and a separate budget for any "startup" items, including capital expenses.
