

## Frequently Asked Questions: AFA 07B-2014-AMH Projects for Assistance and Transition from Homelessness (PATH)

- Do current WVBBHHF allocations received from DHHR constitute as “non-federal” and thus can be considered match funding for the PATH grant? Can Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) funds received from the State Office of Economic Opportunity be considered “non-federal” funds for the purposes of matching funds for the PATH grant?
  - As per the terms and conditions of the PATH Grant Award, the grantee must agree to make available, directly or through donations from public or private entities, non-Federal contributions of at least \$1 (in cash or in kind) for each \$3 of Federal funds. The costs borne by the matching and in-kind contributions are subject to the rules governing allowability in 45 CFR 92.24, including allowability under the applicable cost principles and conformance with other terms and conditions of the award that govern the expenditure of Federal funds. All subrecipient PATH grantees will be required to provide their own match as part of the PATH program. The utilization of any alternative grant funds for PATH Matching must meet all applicable Federal and State requirements and should be approved through the original awarding agency, in this instance OEO.
