Mission Statement

The mission of Rea of Hope is to provide safe, affordable housing for West Virginia women in a positive home-like environment that fosters recovery from alcohol and drug addiction and promotes self-sufficiency.



- **Staffed 24 hours a day to ensure a supportive environment**
- **Structured to encourage personal growth and responsibility**
- **Minimum 6 month commitment must be made**

Rea of Hope Admission Criteria

Some of the requirements are as follows:

- ❑ Must be female age 18 or older
- ❑ Minimum of 30 days clean and sober
- ❑ Primary diagnosis of alcoholism or chemical dependency
- ❑ Recently completed inpatient or outpatient treatment
- ❑ Willing to attend a minimum of five (5) 12-step meetings weekly and obtain a sponsor
- ❑ Must work full-time or be enrolled in school full-time and contribute to a fee of \$70.00 per week, program fee
- ❑ Commit to total abstinence from drugs and alcohol

New Life Apartments Criteria

- ❑ Must be female and at least 18 years of age
- ❑ Maintained abstinence for a minimum of 7 months
- ❑ Successful discharge from ROH Fellowship Home/No monies owed
- ❑ Display fiscal responsibility
- ❑ Committed to taking responsibility for self/recovery
- ❑ Have a sponsor
- ❑ Has developed a sober support system
- ❑ Current full time employment or school enrollment
