

OSHA EXAMINATION NOTICE TO BE GIVEN TO EMPLOYEE

In order to promote a safe work place, your employer may be required by state or federal law to record or report work-related injuries and illnesses, and to monitor your exposure to hazardous substances at the work place. These laws include the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA), the Federal Mine Safety and Health Act (MSHA), and similar state laws.

Health information will be reported to your employer, to permit your employer to comply with the requirements of these laws, if today's examination or treatment is to find out any of the following:

- Whether you have a work-related injury or illness
- The nature of any work-related injury or illness
- Whether you have been exposed to any hazardous substance at your work-place
- The extent of your exposure to this substance

The only health information from today's visit that will be reported to your employer is the information necessary to permit your employer to comply with these laws.
