Step Therapy Proposal Stimulants for Adults (age 21 and older) (Draft)

Prior authorization for stimulants for members over 21 years of age requires:

- 1. Documented diagnosis of ADD or ADHD
- 2. Goals of therapy-Clear goals of therapy from prescriber (Can include academic/work enrollment)
- 3. If members have one of the following diagnoses, a trial of Strattera for thirty (30) days is required before another stimulant will be authorized.
- 4. A trial of Strattera and a long-acting stimulant is required before a short acting stimulant will be approved.
