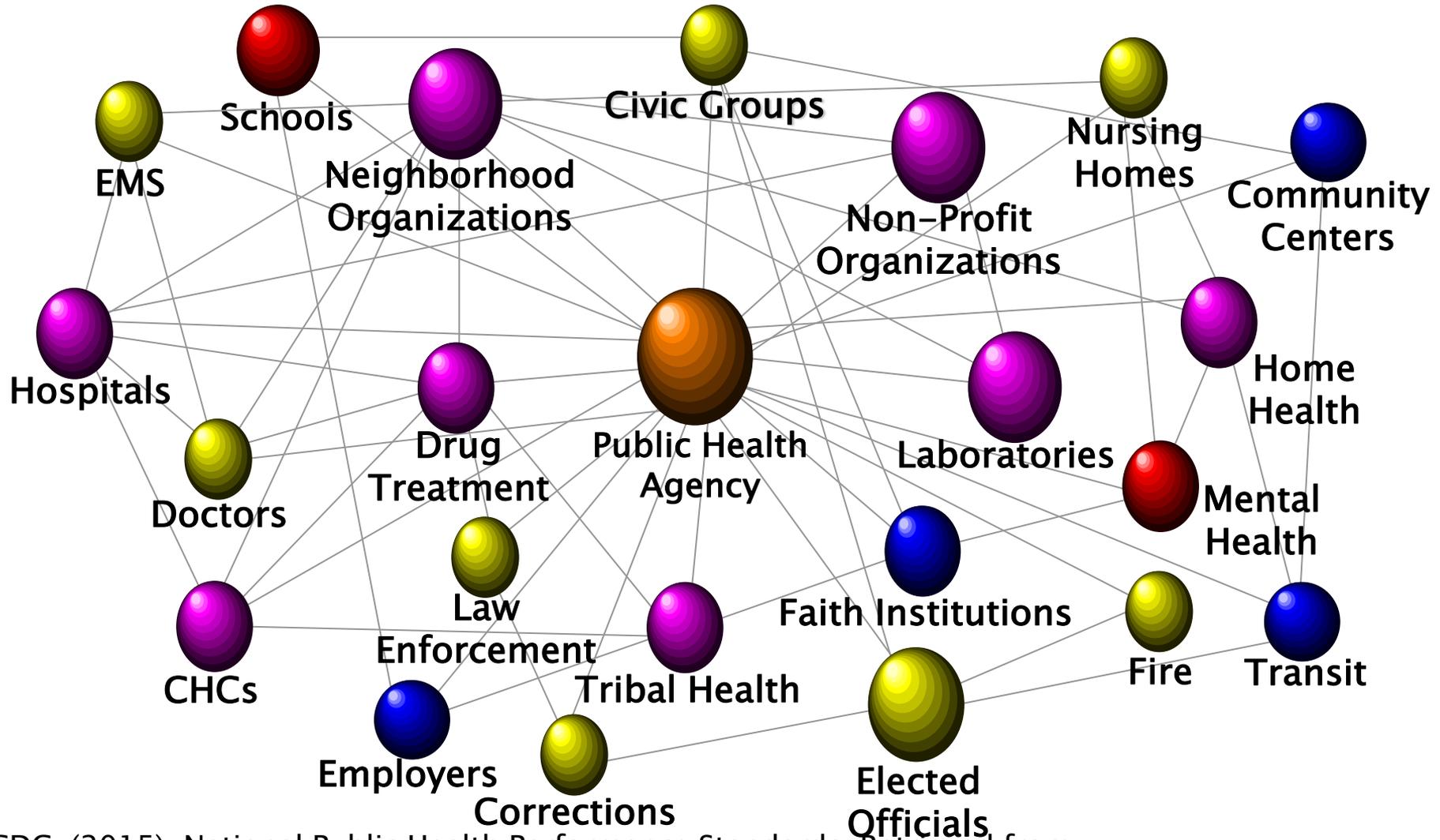

# Community Engagement Operating Definition

Community engagement refers to the process by which community benefit organizations with emphasis on Public Health and individuals build ongoing, permanent relationships for the purpose of applying a collective vision for the benefit of a community. Community engagement primarily deals with the practice of moving communities toward change and sustaining that process.

# Local Public Health System

All public, private, and voluntary entities that contribute to the public's health in a community. A network of entities among community partners with differing roles, relationships, and interactions. All contribute to health and well-being.



# Community Engagement

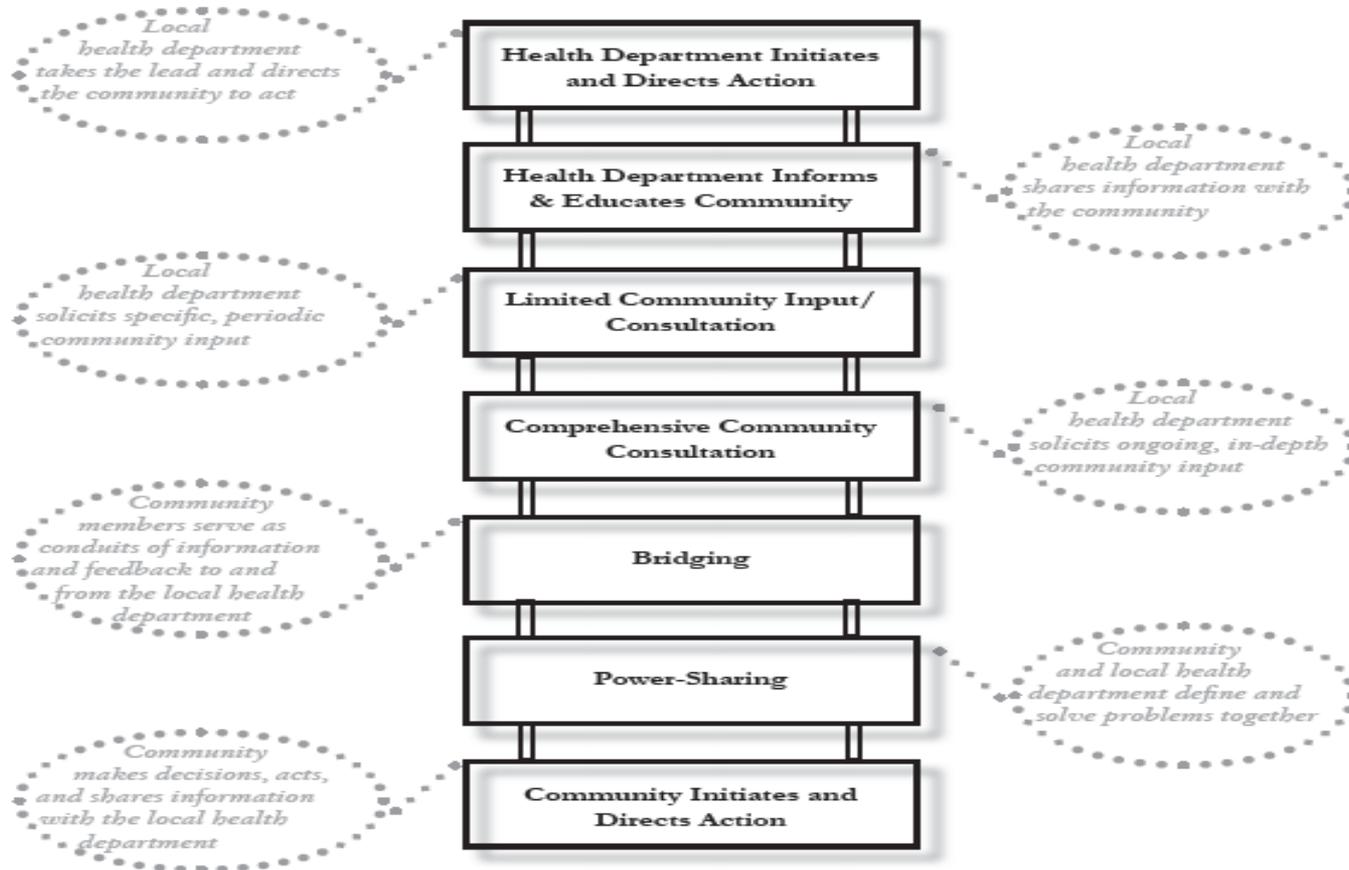
# Community Engagement

# Why is Community Engagement Important?

- ▶ Engagement imparts sustainable change
- ▶ *“Engagement”* leads to *“inclusion”*, *“inclusion”* leads to *“buy in”*
- ▶ Engagement is more than participation
- ▶ Engagement improves the chance of selecting the right solutions

# Successful Community Engagement: What We Can Do?

- ▶ Address the systems, not just the individual (and vice versa)
- ▶ Ensure initiative is appropriate to the community
- ▶ Explain the relevance & benefits of the initiative
- ▶ Empower the community from within
- ▶ Use core Project Partner Group and Stakeholder/Advisory Group effectively from the beginning to the end of the initiative
