

Dear Varicella Surveillance Partners,

There were **10** cases and **0** Outbreaks of Varicella reported during the month of **August**.

A total of **505** WV public schools (elementary, middle/ junior, high school) out of the **685 (74%)** have completed the varicella survey, while **26** Counties reported data for 100% of their schools.
