

Dear Varicella Surveillance Partners,

There were **14** cases and **0** Outbreaks of Varicella reported during the month of **March**.
 A total of **538** out of the **684 (79%)** WV public schools (elementary, middle/ junior, high school) have completed the varicella survey, while **27** Counties reported data for 100% of their schools.
