



Reported Cases of Invasive Group B Streptococcal (IGBS) Disease, By Year of Onset, West Virginia, 1998-2007 (N=307)




Invasive GBS disease became reportable in West Virginia in 2003.


Reported Cases of Invasive Group B Streptococcal (IGBS) Disease, by Month of Onset, West Virginia, 1998-2007 (N=307)



Cases of Invasive Group B Streptococcal Disease by Age Group, West Virginia, 1998-2007 (N=307)




Average Yearly Age Specific Incidence* of Invasive Group B Streptococcal Disease, West Virginia, 1998-2007, (N=307)
