

The content of the above map depicts the number (by county) of surveillance animals (defined as raccoons, skunks, foxes or coyotes) that were tested for rabies and the number of those that tested positive for raccoon-strain rabies. Data represents samples processed by the WV Office of Laboratory Services and from USDA Wildlife Services from 1/1/2012 through 12/31/2012.

Note: All positive rabies results reported by USDA Wildlife Services are documented preliminarily as raccoon-strain rabies, pending CDC confirmation
