



The figure above shows the number of confirmed outbreaks by month of report in West Virginia during 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013.
This graph is updated on a monthly basis




The figure above shows the number of confirmed outbreaks by type of outbreak and month of report in West Virginia in 2013.

MDRO outbreaks can be respiratory illness, enteric illness, urinary tract infection, skin infection, or any other infections. Outbreaks categorized as MDROs are not counted under other categories.
