

## **Outbreak Report for June 2013, West Virginia**

During the month of June, 2013, there were 12 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Of the 12 reported, 9 (75%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters. Seven were reported in healthcare facilities, one in a sports team, and one in a correctional facility.

Six healthcare-associated outbreaks were reported in long-term care facilities (LTCFs) and one in a hospital.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional as some of the outbreaks are under ongoing investigation.

Figure 1 illustrates the types of outbreaks reported during the month and figure 2 depicts the number of outbreaks reported by each region.






Figure 3 depicts confirmed outbreaks by surveillance region from January 1, 2013 to June 30, 2013.
