

# Outbreak Report for August 2016 West Virginia



During the month of August 2016, there were 12 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Eleven (92%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease and one was investigated and determined not to be an outbreak. Three were reported from daycares, two from sports teams, one from a long-term care facility (LTCF), one from a group home, one from a community, one from a correctional facility, and two are part of multi-state investigations.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.





